- 3. **Medical Records**: All medical records are confidential and protected by federal privacy and security regulations. With your authorization, a copy of your medical record can be released to you or transferred to another physician. Please contact our office, and we will be happy to assist you with this process. Please note that there may be a fee for record duplication.
